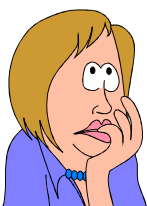

You can write the story yourself, or you can contact us and one of our members would be happy to help you.

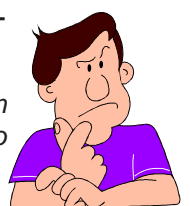


We would prefer entries to be submitted in digital form if possible but we would be happy to type it for you if needed. We can also scan the photographs and return the originals to you.
